## **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this policy is to define "successful completion" of the United States Medical Licensing Examination® ("USMLE") and the Comprehensive Osteopathic Medical Licensing Examination of the United States ("COMLEX-USA") as it pertains to K.A.R. 100-7-1.<sup>1</sup> This policy is intended to be a guidance document under K.S.A. 77-438.

## **AUTHORITY:**

K.S.A. 77-438; K.A.R. 100-7-1.

## **POLICY:**

Successful completion of the USMLE is defined as passing Step 1, Step 2 CK, and Step 3.<sup>2</sup>

• For each applicant for licensure by examination to practice medicine and surgery or osteopathic medicine in Kansas submitted on or after July 21, 2021, Step 2 CS attempts will not be counted towards the seven total attempts in K.A.R. 100-7-1.

Successful completion of the COMLEX-USA is defined as passing Level 1, Level 2-CE, and Level  $3.^3$ 

• For each applicant for licensure by examination to practice osteopathic medicine in Kansas submitted on or after February 11, 2021, COMLEX-USA Level 2-PE attempts will not be counted towards the seven total attempts in K.A.R. 100-7-1.
