Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to memorialize the authority granted to the Executive Director and General Counsel on August 10, 2018 pursuant to K.S.A. 77-551(c) and to communicate guidelines and procedures for the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts regarding handling procedural matters in pending administrative cases that arise prior to or between meeting/hearing dates.

Authority:

K.S.A. 77-551(c).

Policy/Authorization:

The Executive Director and General Counsel are authorized, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-551(c), to issue decisions and orders on purely procedural/legal matters in administrative cases that arise prior to the Board hearing on the case. This includes, but is not necessarily limited to, motions for continuance, case management orders, evidentiary objections, motions in limine, and motions to convert a proceeding to a formal hearing. This may include any necessary pre-hearing conferences pursuant to K.S.A. 77-517 with the parties' attorneys to deal with such matters. A summary report of such decisions will be provided to the full Board at the next Board meeting. This policy supersedes any prior policies to the extent that any prior policies are inconsistent with this policy in any way.
